

GHANA AND JAPAN CULTURAL EVENT AT KICK BACK CAFÉ **ON SUNDAY, 24TH SEPTEMBER, 2017**

This Mission, together with a Japanese Gospel Group (Heavenese) on Sunday, 24th September, 2017, organised a Ghana and Japan cultural event, as part of the celebration of 60 years of bilateral relations between the two (2) countries, at the Kick Back Café at Chofu, north of Tokyo.

Over one hundred participants who attended the event, were treated to Ghanaian music and dance by the Boye Brothers, a Ghanaian cultural group based in Japan, and Japanese melody by the Heavenese band.
