## <u>Summary on JICA's July 19<sup>th</sup> News release for adoption of Terumo's proposal toward Safety Transfusion project in</u> Ghana

Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) announced the adoption of 12 proposals from The 6th JICA public offering "Program to promote private technologies for society/economy development in developing countries". This program has started from 2013 and this time become 6th public offering with selection of 10 proposals as general category plus 2 proposals as special category for healthcare and medical having combination with medical service, devises and system so that accelerate contribution to healthcare sector to developing countries with more than twice the normal budget limit.

One of the two special selections for medical category is to encourage prevention of Transfusion transmitted Infection with implementing Mirasol Pathogen Reduction Technology System in Ghana Republic proposed by Terumo Corporation. Mirasol has already been implemented for Platelet and Plasma components in Europe and other regions and this is the first time to implement Mirasol for Whole Blood. Terumo will take this opportunity to promulgate Mirasol continuously in the world to contribute to the improvement of blood safety.
