

**REPORT ON COMMONWEALTH REMEMBRANCE DAY CEREMONY AT THE  
HODOGAYA CEMETERY, IN YOKOHAMA,  
ON SUNDAY 13TH NOVEMBER 2016**

His Excellency Mr. S.J.K. PARKER-ALLOTEY on Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2016, was among Heads of Commonwealth Missions, other diplomatic officials and service representatives of organisations who laid wreaths on the occasion of the anniversary of the Commonwealth Remembrance Day at the Hodogaya Cemetery in Yokohama.

2. The Head of Mission was accompanied by Nana Kwabena AMAGYEI (First Secretary/Consular Affairs) to represent the Mission. The ceremony which was from 10:30 to 11:30 hours, had about twenty (20) Heads of Commonwealth Missions in attendance including those of Her Britannic Majesty, the United States of America, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Nigeria, Malawi and Botswana. Furthermore, representatives from the Japan Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Japan Ministry of Defense, the Kanagawa Prefectural Government, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, the United States Forces in Japan and the United Nation Command (Rear) among others, also laid wreaths.
